Dear Rotary friends around the world,

<u>Beirut's explosion</u> has been classified as the biggest and worst we have ever experienced in the history of our city. It was 1/13th of Hiroshima's nuclear explosion. So far, at least 200 have died, more than 7,000 injured, 8000 homes and many hospitals partially or completely destroyed, and 300.000 displaced and homeless.

The Rotary and Rotaract clubs in Lebanon have mobilized their member volunteers to address food, medical and shelter needs. If anyone wishes to donate, they can send the funds through the bank account details below. The immediate support will be a preparation of food boxes and medical supplies, babies' kits for affected families.

- 3. At least 2 sterile eye dressings
- 4. Triangular bandages
- 5. Crêpe rolled bandages
- 6. Safety pins
- 7. Disposable sterile gloves
- 8. Tweezers
- 9. Scissors

10. Alcohol-free cleansing wipes

- 11. Sticky tape
- 12. Thermometer (preferably digital)
- 13. Skin rash cream such as hydrocortisone
- 14. Cream or spray to relieve insect bites and stings

15. Antiseptic cream

- 16. Painkillers such as paracetamol
- 17. Cough medicine
- 18. Antihistamine cream or tablets
- 19. Distilled water for cleaning wounds
- 20. Eye wash and eye bath
- 21. Face mask
